High season for the vast array of unique and interesting flowers, fillers and foliage from Australia is about to begin.

Kicking off in May / June, the season for these products will keep on going strong until late November. Flown directly into Canada weekly, all products are pre-cooled before departure from Australia and then immediately pre-cooled to 2 degrees Celsius upon arrival to ensure maximum freshness and vase life. When properly cut and hydrated in preservative treated water, Australian flowers and foliage are generally long lasting and can be arranged on their own or mixed in with more traditional cut flower varieties like roses to create a stunning effect of colors and textures!
