

Originally a fall product available only in red, hypericum can now be found in vivid shades of peach, pink, red, orange, yellow and green and is available year round from Ecuador. Grading for hypericum includes the size of the berry (fruit), the number of berries per stem and the length of the stems, which ranges from 50 to 80cm. Quality hypericum lasts for 3 weeks, has bright, plump berries, deep green crisp foliage and the appropriate number of berries per stem according to their grade.
